- Treat all people and communities fairly and equally with Council projects.

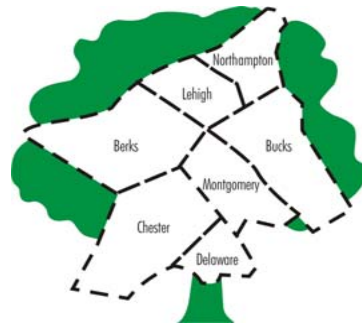

## Commitment:
